## Holiday Safety & Winter Weather Reminders

As the Holidays and winter weather approach, please keep in mind the following safety tips to keep you and your family safe throughout the season.

- Never keep valuables in plain sight in your vehicles. Store your presents and shopping bags in your trunk and always lock your vehicle.
  - Park in well lit areas and be aware of your surroundings.
- Do not leave candles burning when you are away from home, even for a few minutes. This poses a serious fire hazard.
- When using a fresh Christmas tree, keep it well watered or have it sprayed with a flame retardant material to minimize the risk of fire danger.
- Do not overload circuits when plugging in Christmas lights and other electric decorations.
- Keep glass and other breakable decorations and ornaments up high and out of the reach of children.
- Do not get on a ladder to hang decorations in icy, wet weather.
- Keep your thermostat set above 60 degrees when you are on vacation to reduce the risk of frozen pipes and flooding.
- If you plan on leaving town during the Holidays, leave a few interior and exterior lights on to deter criminal activity around your home. Let a trusted neighbor know where you will be and how you may be reached in an emergency. Ask them to keep an eye on your home while you are away.
- Change your furnace filter every month to prolong the life and performance of your furnace.
- Disconnect your garden hose from the outside faucet to prevent freezing.
